

# **AUGUST 2011 REPORT FOR THE** **NICHOLAS COUNTY CONSERVATION DISTRICT**

August 3, 2011: Monthly meeting was held at 6:30pm at the Nicholas County Extension Office.

August 4, 2011: Monthly State Cost Share reports were sent to Frankfort to the Division of Conservation.

August 8, 2011: Secretary set up a booth at the Readifest at Nicholas County High School gymnasium to promote this year's poster/essay contest. We had a great response, 75 kids signed up to participate.

August 15, 2011: Talked with Bluegrass Recycling Services about our deceased animal removal contract. There will no longer be a fee to the producers to have their animals picked up.

August 17, 2011: Talked with a Fish/Wildlife Officer about helping to promote our poster/essay contest. They have agreed to talk with students to try and have more participation this year. Also, talked to Nathan Gregory with the Clay Wildlife Farm to see if he could help out as well and he agreed also.

August 19, 2011: Visited New Beginning Christian School to talk about the poster/essay contest.

August 31, 2011: Went on a farm visit to take a look at some of the trees we handed out at our last tree give-away.

The No-Till Drill was rented out 4 times during the month with the hay wrapper and lime buggy being rented once.

The Secretary helped local producers with 5 phase I applications and questions.

The staff handled 26 in office visits from producers and 41 calls concerning conservations questions.
