2012 TAX ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE Relating to the Annual Levy for 2012 Property Taxes in Nicholas County, Kentucky.

WHEREAS, the 2012 Nicholas County property assessment has been certified as follows:

Real Estate	212,707,914.
Tangible Personal Property	4,315,386.
Motor Vehicle	41,151,436.
Watercraft	838,325.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of Nicholas County, Kentucky:

SECTION ONE. There is levied for year 2012, the general ad valorem tax rate per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the Special District or other fund as indicated.
